A bachelor's degree in computer information technology prepares students for careers that go beyond programming and networking. With the online Bachelor of Science in Computer Information Technology program at SNHU, students follow one of two tracks. The traditional BS gives them a broad liberal arts education alongside the technical skills that employers are looking for. The alternate track has a business core that prepares students with business-specific skills such as marketing, finance and accounting to supplement their computing education.

Employment opportunities in computer information technology continue to be strong. The IT industry is projected to be the second largest area of job growth in the United States and is expected to grow by 30 percent through 2018. The online BS in CIT from SNHU can be paired with minors so students can pursue other interests and expand their career goals. For example, the BS can be combined with accounting, international business or game design and development to create highly focused career paths in each degree program.
