Bachelor of Arts in Early Childhood Education



Become qualified to teach preschool through third-grade students with Southern New Hampshire University's B.A. in Early Childhood Education (K-3).

You'll feel confident that you will make a difference in the lives of young students as you lead the classroom with knowledge, leadership skills and practical. In addition to learning about child development, family systems, innovative curriculum and instruction methods, you may choose to pursue a dual certification in teaching special education, with no additional credits required. Alternatively, you may also choose to specialize with a minor.

The early childhood education program leads to teacher certification in New Hampshire, which is reciprocal in most states, and culminates in a 16-week student teaching experience, where you will work full-time with an established teacher.

Education students keep e-portfolios that help them with their student teaching and with their job searches after graduation. There are also opportunities for networking with area day care centers, superintendents and principals.
