If you like numbers, people, travel and independence, consider majoring in accounting at Southern New Hampshire University. SNHU's online program will put you on track for a variety of professional certifications, including certified public accountant (CPA), certified management accountant (CMA) and certified fraud examiner (CFE). Demand for these professionals is on the rise.

SNHU students graduate with knowledge of accounting procedures, regulations and ethics along with skills in communication, information technology, teamwork and problem-solving, enabling them to make an immediate contribution in the workplace.

To meet the needs of the profession, SNHU offers specific concentrations. The Finance track prepares students for meaningful employment in banking, investments and personal and corporate finance. The Forensic Accounting and Fraud Examination program teaches students to identify fraud and protect corporate and personal financial interests. Graduate programs can help students meet the 150-credit hour requirement some states have for those who wish to sit for the CPA exam.

Opportunities for graduates exist in the fields of public accounting, e-commerce, private industry, government, nonprofit institutions

and in the international arena. Job growth for accounting professionals is expected to be 22 percent through 2018 according to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.
