Southern New Hampshire University's finance/economics degree program is like a dual major, with emphasis on both areas. Students examine the behavior of the economy and its relationship to business and government, and study the funding and investment needs of corporations, individuals and institutions.

The primary goal of the program is to establish a solid foundation in the applied and theoretical areas of international and domestic finance, business and economics.

Finance/Economics Degree Curriculum

Courses in the finance/economics degree program cover banking, macroeconomics, corporate finance and investments.

You can also choose finance/economics electives in managerial and international economics, multinational corporate finance, economics of social issues and professional sports, risk management and investment analysis.

All finance/economics courses are taught by full-time faculty members who also serve as mentors.
