A professionally oriented program taught by faculty who work in the field, SNHU's online justice studies program provides students with the skills to analyze and critique operational and public policy from social, administrative, juridical, philosophical and managerial perspectives. No GMAT or GRE required.

The interdisciplinary focus goes beyond criminology and law, with an emphasis on management and leadership in the justice system. You are encouraged to explore aligned disciplines, such as public administration, organizational leadership, finance, accounting, and information technology. Students may also earn an optional Concentration in Terrorism & Homeland Security.

SNHU's online program enables you and your classmates from all over the country to fit course work into your busy schedules. The program is 36 or 37 credits, based on whether or not you select the thesis option.

Career Outlook

Graduates will find the job outlook in the justice studies industry is healthy. According to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, a wide variety of positions in government agencies such as in the Federal Bureau of Investigation, Drug Enforcement Agency and U.S. Marshals Department are expected to see a 13.4 percent growth through 2016.
