The History of The Quill

The restaurant's name, *The Quill*, evokes the history of the university, which was founded as a school of accounting in the early 1930s. The quill, a pen used by colonial accountants, also appears as a staff held by the university's Penmen mascot in Athletics logos and as a feather in the university logo.

Early scribes wrote and decorated the pages of their manuscripts including the Bible and the Magna Carta with quill pens. Artists used them to sign their masterpieces with the quill. Wars were started, won and lost, and some were even averted by the stroke of a quill. Great works of literature, daily ship logs, correspondence and historical documents that changed the world, such as the Declaration of Independence and the U.S. Constitution were written and signed with the quill pen.
