Early action applications may be submitted any time prior to Nov. 15 and will be reviewed based on grades and test scores through the junior year of high school. Admission decisions on early action applicants will be made by Dec. 15.
- Rolling Admission** (*application completed including first-quarter senior-year grades*)
Most students apply under the rolling admission plan, in which applications are reviewed throughout the year for all future semesters. It is recommended, however, that freshman and transfer applicants apply prior to March 15 for the fall, and prior to Nov. 15 for the spring semester.
