The Updated Search Screens for CMS 7

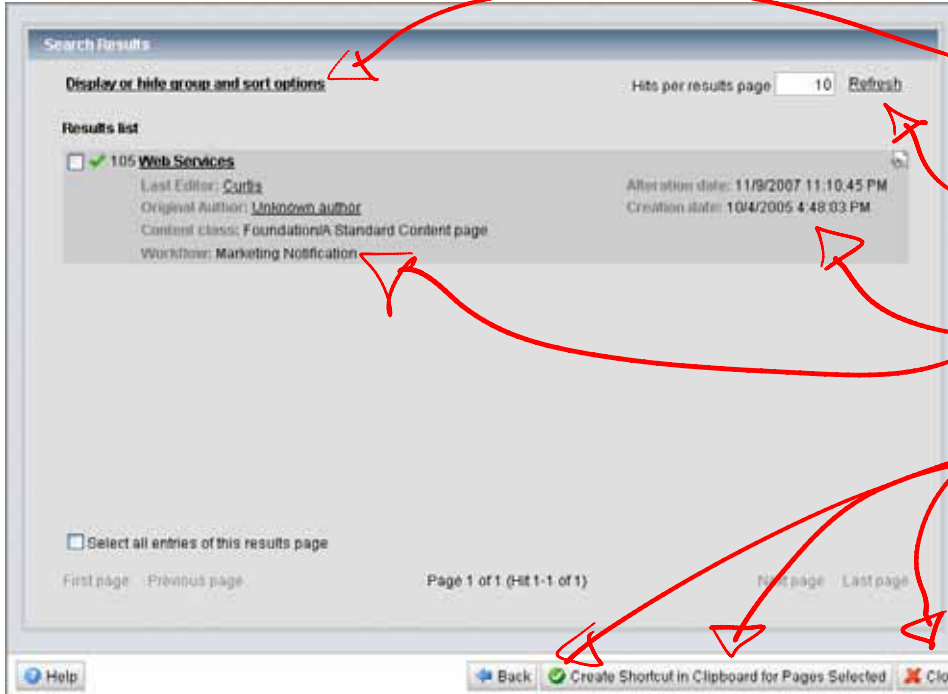
Once you select a new field you must put a value in it.
