Women's Faculty Scholarship

The Southern New Hampshire University (SNHU) Women's Faculty Scholarship was created in 1990 by the women faculty of SNHU (then New Hampshire College). The scholarship acknowledges and supports students who demonstrate an ongoing commitment to human and environmental rights, economic justice, gender equity and community service. Each year SNHU Women's Faculty Scholarships will be awarded to those applicants who best represent those values.

Eligibility

Any full-time student may apply regardless of race, gender or nationality.

Undergraduate students may apply **after completing one academic year** at SNHU.

Graduate students may apply **after completing one academic term** at SNHU.

Prior scholarship applicants and recipients may re-apply.

Selection

The SNHU Women's Faculty Scholarship Committee selects recipients based upon academic record, past and continued commitment to human rights, and financial need.

Award

Scholarship awards will be applied towards student tuition for the 2009-2010 academic year. The size of awards varies with the number of selected recipients in a given year and with the scholarship merits of each candidate. Each recipient's award is based upon how closely that candidate meets scholarship objectives and criteria. In the past, recipients have received from \$1000 to \$3000.

Process

Applications are due by March 23rd.

Candidates will be notified on or before April 30th.

Instructions for completing and submitting application.

1. Application and attachments must be received by March 23rd.
2. Please type or print clearly. Show N/A for not applicable.
3. Attach the following to the completed application:
 - a. Three reference letters (at least one letter from a recent instructor, employer, or supervisor preferred).
 - b. A transcript of courses completed with grades.
 - c. A 500-word autobiography, emphasizing the following:
 - Commitment to human or environmental rights, economic or gender equity and plans for continuing this commitment at SNHU
 - Academic excellence
 - Financial need, and
 - Other information you believe pertinent to your candidacy.
 - d. Permission to request relevant information from the SNHU Financial Aid Office.
