The Residence Agreement must be returned to the Office of the Bursar and financial clearance obtained prior to room assignments. If you are not presently in residence, you must pay a \$50 damage deposit. Billing will be for two 8 week periods. BASHA students are billed for housing as a part of their total academic packages. Interest accrues on any unpaid balance. Failure to make payments is grounds for termination of this contract. Students must notify the Office of Residence Life at least one week prior to checking out of residence in order for billing to be adjusted properly and timely. There will be no credit given if you decide to leave campus for a week's vacation (or any period of time) during the summer, unless you formally check out of your residence. Students who are not registered for University residences for the 2009-2010 academic year, summer housing Term B will terminate on (date to be determined). BASHA I housing ends on August 6, 2009. BASHA II housing ends on August 7, 2009. Students enrolled in CE classes who are not registered for Fall housing, summer housing ends on August 22, 2009. Graduate housing ends on August 29, 2009. Students are expected to depart residence 24 hours after their last final exam.

I understand that the University reserves all rights concerning inspection of rooms, assignments, or re-assignments of residence and/or the termination of this contract. I further understand by this contract, that fines may be levied when an infraction of any rules or regulations have been discovered and proven in accordance with the University's judicial process.

The University is not responsible for loss of personal property in university housing by fire, theft, or any other cause.
