Transfer Credit Policy

- There is no limit on CLEP/DSST credits for Active-Duty, Reservist, and National Guard servicemembers as long as students meet the institutional residency requirement of thirty (30) credits.
- Excess general education credits are transferred as free elective credit, if available.
- Students must take/transfer 12 credits of 300- to 400-level coursework in the B.A. General Studies program.
- This guide is based upon SNHU Online 2020/2021 Academic Catalog at time of enrollment and this institution's equivalent academic year. Transfer equivalents earned prior or subsequent to this academic year will be evaluated on a caseby-case basis for transfer equivalency.
- Students must earn a grade of C- or better for course transfer.
- Students may transfer up to 90 credits if previous credits earned meet SNHU Online's degree requirements and academic standards for transfer.
- There are no "final year" or "final semester" residency requirements for Active-duty, Reservist, and National Guard servicemembers, and their family members. Academic residency can be completed at any time while Active-duty, Reservist, and National Guard servicemembers, and their family members are enrolled.
- Original transcripts are required for formal review and transfer of credit awarded from institution(s), CLEP, and DSST examinations.
