• RN to BSN Admission Requirements:				
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• An earned diploma or associate degree in nursing from a state-approved or nationally accredited nursing program and a 2.5 minimum cumulative GPA. Students with a cumulative GPA between 2.0 and 2.49 on the degree or diploma awarding transcript may be provisionally accepted and must also meet the licensure requirements.</li> <li>• Evidence of unencumbered state RN licensure (due upon completion of the first BS in Nursing course)</li> <li>• If less than 36 credits of clinical nursing electives are transferred, additional credits may be evaluated based on student's LPN or other precatory program. Otherwise, the RN License for the State Board of Nursing has approved the requirements for education.</li> <li>• Daily access to the Internet</li> <li>• To pursue an accelerated RN to MSN, you must have an active unencumbered license to practice as a registered nurse and an undergraduate GPA of 3.0. If you have a GPA below 3.0, but higher than 2.67, you are eligible for provisional acceptance. If you are an RN to BSN student interested in the Accelerated RN to MSN, contact an SNHU admission counselor or your academic advisor for more information.</li> </ul>				
• Students may transfer up to 90 credits if previous credits earned meet SNHU-COCE's degree requirements and academic standards for transfer.				
• Students must take at least 30 credits (ten classes) at SNHU-COCE to be awarded a bachelor's degree.
