Comprehensive Clinical Inventory (CCI)

The Clinical Competency Inventory (CCI) is used twice during the candidate's clinical practice/student teaching. This performance-based assessment is introduced at the beginning of the clinical practice to guide the development of the teaching candidate and to provide feedback on the candidate's strengths and areas of improvement. It is first used to provide feedback to the teaching candidate on observed lessons at the mid-point of clinical practice. It is closely aligned with the Observation and Conference Report (O&C) and helps guide the development of the candidate.

The assessment is also used as a summative assessment at the completion of the clinical experience/student teaching, during the last observation. The CCI is meant to be a cumulative assessment of competencies that the university based clinical educator/supervisor (UBCE) and school based clinical educator/cooperating teacher (SBCE) have observed throughout the clinical practice.

The CCI is aligned with the revised CAEP, InTASC, and NH standards and directly assesses candidates' proficiency in those standards.

The CCI has been designed to provide feedback on the progress of individual teaching candidates who are completing their clinical practice/student teaching experience in their teacher preparation program. This performance-based assessment measures key competencies aligned to the 2022 revised CAEP standards, the 2011 InTASC standards, and the New Hampshire standards that are required of all teaching candidates prior to being recommended for certification. This standards-based observational instrument specifies the defining set of competencies that pre-service teachers should demonstrate before being recommended for certification in their states.

Scoring of the Assessment:

The following rating scale is used to score each candidate in each of the 38 indicators of the CCI.

4: Advanced Proficient (Exemplary Practice) -- Point value: 4.0 - 3.5

3: Proficient (Basic Competence) --Point value: 3.4 - 2.75
2: Novice (Limited Competence) --Point value: 2.74 - 1.5
1: Emergent (Exhibits Difficulty) --Point value: 1.4 - 0

For the Final Assessment, all 38 indicators are rated. The following scale is used to assess the candidate: Advanced Proficient (4) = 152 points; Proficient (3) = 114 points; Novice (2) = 76 points; Emergent (1) = 38 points. A candidate needs a minimum of 114 points (2.75 average) to pass clinical practice/student teaching and be recommended for certification.

Analysis and Interpretation:

The following data is from Fall 2023 and Spring 2024. The data is disaggregated by the licensure area, race/ethnicity, and gender at the undergraduate and post-baccalaureate level, as well as for the EPP as a whole. In order to have more robust data for comparison purposes, all licensure areas for middle and high school level content were grouped together as "Secondary". Licensure areas of Elementary, Early Childhood and Special Education were also combined. Race/ethnicity is identified as white/non-white, again to provide more robust data. Non-white includes Hispanic/Latin X, Asian, Black or African American, American Indian, Alaskan Native, Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islanders, or a combination of two or more races.

Data for Fall 2023 and Spring 2024 show that a total of 35 candidates were assessed in their second semester of clinical practice. The mean score in all areas exceeded a 3.0 which is above our total benchmark of 2.75. Both University Based Clinical Educators (UBCE) and School Based Clinical Educators (SBCE) scored candidates highest in R1.4 Professional Responsibility (3.69 and 3.58 out of 4). Candidates also excelled in R1.1 Learner & Learning (3.45 and 3.56 out of 4) Candidates scored lowest in R1.2 Content (3.29 and 3.37 out of 4).

When comparing SBCE and UBCE scores, it was noted that overall, SBCE tends to have higher scores than UBCE. The faculty determined that this would be based on the amount of time that SBCE spend with teacher candidates as compared to UBCE. SBCE are with candidates every day while UBCE observe teacher candidates 2-3 times a semester.

Faculty agreed that comparing the demographics is very difficult as the large majority of our students fall into one category, the sample size of the other categories make comparison difficult.

DATA

CAEP Standard R1 Components: Means for all EPP candidates are at 3.29 or above out of a possible 4 in all four CAEP R1 components/InTASC categories assessed by the CCI. EPP candidates' mean scores in the CCI on the four R1 components as assessed by University-Based Clinical educators (UBCE) for the Fall 2023 & Spring 2024 administration indicate that candidates do best in the Professional Responsibility and Learner and Learning components of standard R1. UBCEs rated candidates highest in the Professional Responsibility (R1.4). EPP candidates' mean scores in the CCI on the our R1 Components as assessed by School Based Clinical Educators (SBCE) for Fall 2023 and Spring 2024 administration indicate that candidates do best in the Professional Responsibility and learning and Learning components of standard R1. SBCE rated candidates highest in Professional Responsibility (R1.4) which matches with UBCE scores.

R1.1 Learner and Learning: In Learner and Learning, the EPP mean was for UBCE was 3.45 out of a possible 4 and for SBCE was 3.56. Means for the individual components of standard R1.1 were Learner Development (InTASC 1) 3.53 (UBCE) and 3.63 (SBCE); Learner Differences (InTASC 2): 3.33 (UBCE) and 3.49 (SBCE) and Learning Environment (InTASC 3): 3.50 (UBCE) and 3.57 (SBCE). An area of improvement noted by faculty is Learning Differences 2.2 (3.29 UBCE and 3.46 SBCE) and 2.3 (3.31 UBCE and 3.51 SBCE). These are both components that include incorporating multicultural content into lessons and utilizing strategies to support English Language Learners.

R1.2 Content: In Content R1.2, the EPP mean for UBCE was 3.29 out of a possible 4 and for SBCE it was 3.37. Means for the individual components of standard R1.2 were Content Knowledge (inTASC 4) was 3.42 (UBCE) and 3.42 (SBCE), Application of Content (inTASC 5) was 3.27 (UBCE) and 3.35 (SBCE). An area of growth would be 5.1 as it involves integrating multiple content areas into lesson plans which many young teachers find difficult.

R1.3 Instructional Practice: In Instructional Practice R1.3, the EPP mean for UBCE was 3.38 out of a possible 4 and for SBCE it was 3.41. Means for individual components of standard R1.3 include: Assessment (inTASC 6) was 3.31 (UBCE) and 3.46 (SBCE), Planning for Instruction (inTASC 7) 3.45 (UBCE) and 3.41 (SBCE), Instructional Strategies (inTASC 8) was 3.34 (UBCE) and 3.39 (SBCE).

R1.4: Professional Responsibility: Data from the CCI indicate that R1.4 is where candidates continue to excel with an EPP overall mean of 3.69 (UBCE) and 3.58 (SBCE). Means for individual components of standard R1.4 include: Professional Learning and Ethical Practice (inTASC 9) was 3.46 (UBCE) and 3.46 (SBCE), Leadership and Collaboration (inTASC 10) was 3.66 (UBCE) and 3.50 (SBCE), Professional Responsibility (inTASC 9) was 3.86 (UBCE) and 3.70 (SBCE). This final component are the highest of all 10 inTASC standards.

InTASC Standards: CCI mean scores for the 10 InTASC standards for the EPP are all above 3.0 out of 4 as assessed by SBCEs and UBCEs. Clinical educators agree that candidates excel on InTASC Standard 9, Professional and Ethical Responsibility. Candidates also perform well in Learner Development (InTASC 1) and Planning (inTASC 7). The lowest mean across programs is on Standard 2: Learner Differences, although the mean for the EPP is above 3.0 (out of 4).
