

- 1) Apply online at www.snhu.edu/apply
- 2) Submit the following documents: (forms can be found online at www.snhu.edu/military)
 - a. High school attestation form
 - **b.** Official college or university transcripts from every institution attended (We can request them for you by filling out the Transcript Request Form)
 - **c.** DD-214 and military transcripts (*Transcripts can be requested through the Joint Services website*)

When your admission specialist has received your completed application, you will be contacted by phone with your admission decision within 30 days. Once a service member is admitted to the day program, the tuition deposit will be waived after SNHU's veteran's certifying officials confirm that all benefits paperwork is received.
