All Direct School Expenses Paid

SNHU participates in the Yellow Ribbon Program. For eligible students, SNHU will contribute a portion of the tuition and fees that exceed the post 9-11 GI Bill benefit, and the VA will match that amount. In addition, if you're enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student at our main campus in Manchester, you may be eligible for a housing stipend.

More Veteran Services than Any New Hampshire School

You won't find another university in New Hampshire that offers more services specifically for veterans than SNHU. From admissions to disability services to counseling to academic advising to career development, we have dedicated resources to help you successfully transition to college, complete your degree, and move to the next stage in your life — whether that's with the military, in the corporate world, or in higher education as you pursue an advanced degree.

Access to the New Veterans Lounge
