USO/RP6 CENTER TRANSITION SCHOLARSHIP RULES & GUIDELINES



The **USO/RP6 Center Transition Scholarship** at the College of Online and Continuing Education at Southern New Hampshire University (SNHU) is awarded to a limited number of transitioning servicemembers participating in the United Service Organizations (USO) Transition 360 Alliance program at designated RP6/USO Centers.

Scholarship details and disbursements:

A total of five (5) scholarships will be awarded nationally in the first year (2016-2017), ten (10) scholarships in year two (2017-2018) and fifteen (15) scholarships in year three (2018-2019). The amount will be at a **75% discounted rate of tuition** and is available to both undergraduate and graduate candidates.

The discount will remain with the student throughout their enrollment for a designated program. To receive the 75% tuition discount each term, the recipient must maintain full-time student status and satisfactory scholastic standing.

To qualify, applicants must:

- Be a transitioning active-duty United States Military service member with less than 12 months remaining of their duty obligation in one of the five armed service branches (Air Force, Army, Coast Guard, Marine Corps and Navy)
- Be new to Southern New Hampshire University (excludes current students)
- Complete their application on the designated form and include a 500-word candidate-written essay (further details on application form)
- Provide a letter of reference from senior enlisted advisor
- Provide a letter of reference from a field grade officer (O-4 or above)
- Submit their application and essay on site at their local USO RP/6 Center

Note that other selection criteria includes but is not limited to: length of service, combat deployments, valorous and other awards.

Scholarships will be awarded without regard to sex, race, color, national origin, religion, age or sexual orientation. The recipients of the scholarships will be selected by Southern New Hampshire University. The decisions of Southern New Hampshire University regarding any aspect of the scholarship program (including the application and selection process) are final and binding.





USO/RP6 CENTER TRANSITION SCHOLARSHIP RULES & GUIDELINES CONTINUED



Upon selection, applicants must:

- Apply to the College of Online and Continuing Education at SNHU within a year of their scholarship notification. If the recipient fails to enroll during this period, their scholarship will be revoked and credited to another deserving applicant.
- Submit all of the scholarship materials to the USO RP/6 Center by December 1 of each scholarship year.

Scholarship recipients will be selected by January 1 of each scholarship year and then notified soon thereafter.

Restrictions:

- Scholarships can only be applied against tuition in the case of the College of Online and Continuing Education courses and will not cover in-person or on-campus classes at SNHU's Manchester campus or regional centers.
- Scholarships are not transferable and cannot be redeemed for cash or any other consideration.
- Scholarships do not cover books, electronic resources or any fees.
- Scholarships will be voided should the recipient withdraw or discontinue classes for more than one term or become otherwise ineligible according to the guidelines above.
- **SNHU does not combine discounts; the 75% tuition discount will be calculated based on the non-discounted tuition rate available to the majority of students.**

- Complete FERPA release
- Complete publicity release
